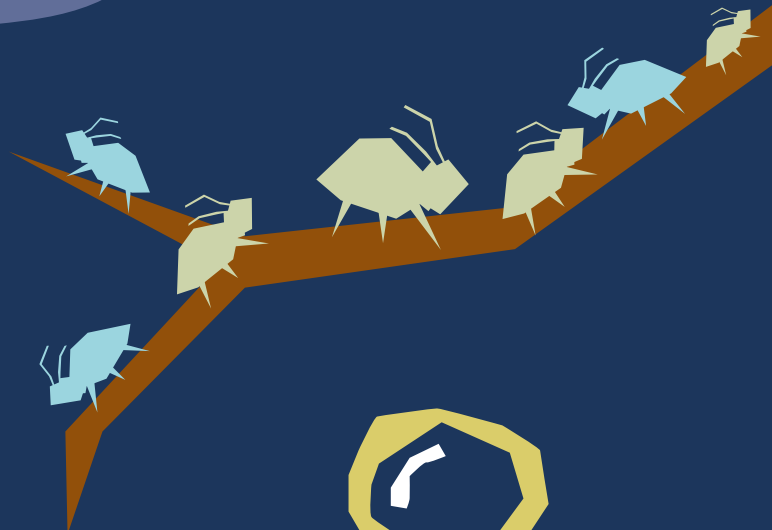
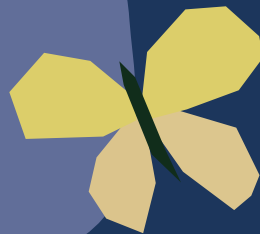

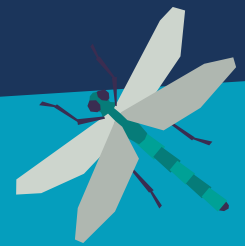
## Challenge Awards
