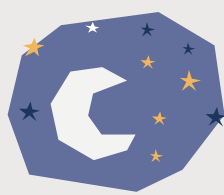
Learn the science behind solar eclipses and see what they look like from space!

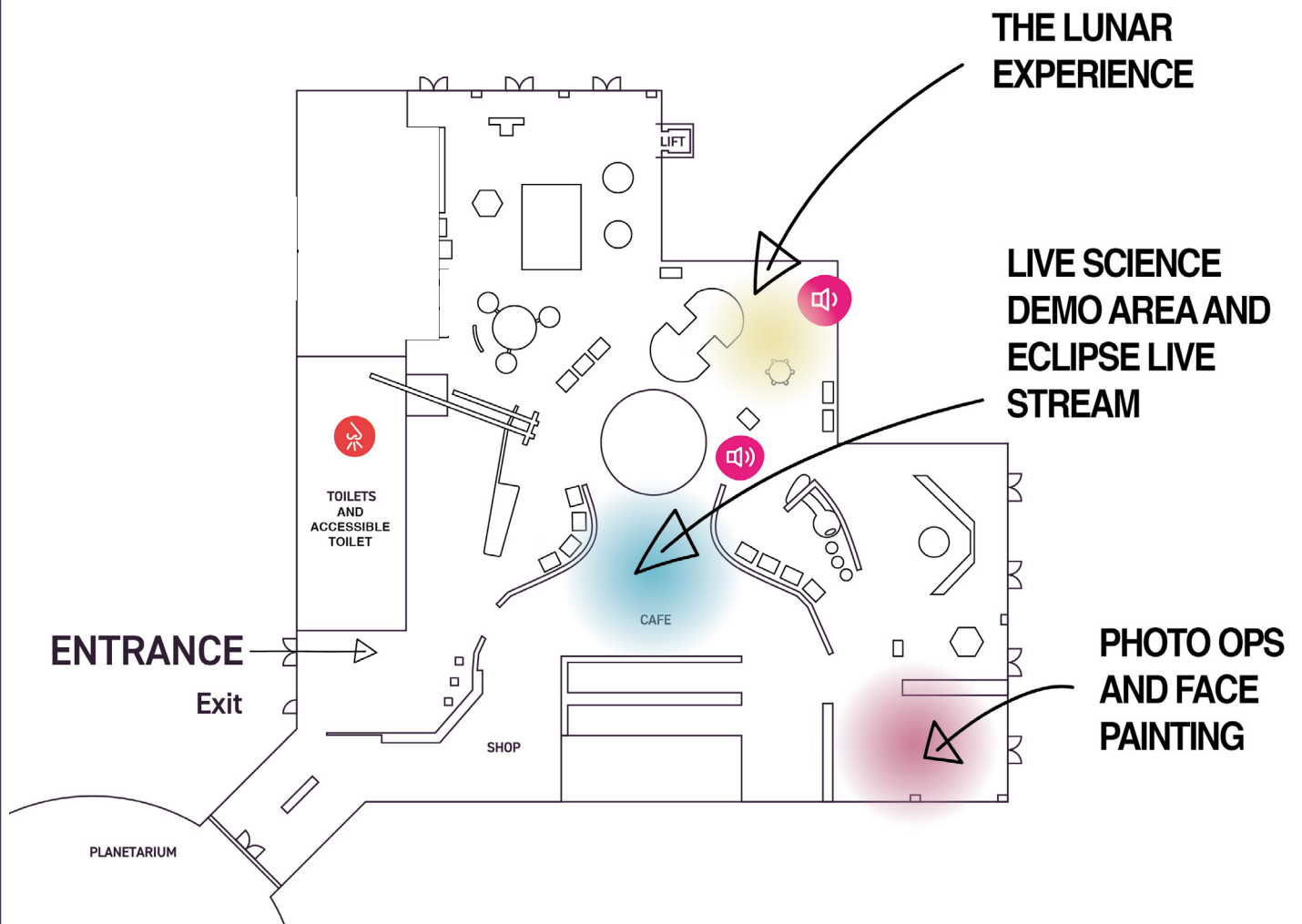


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CENTRE MAP
