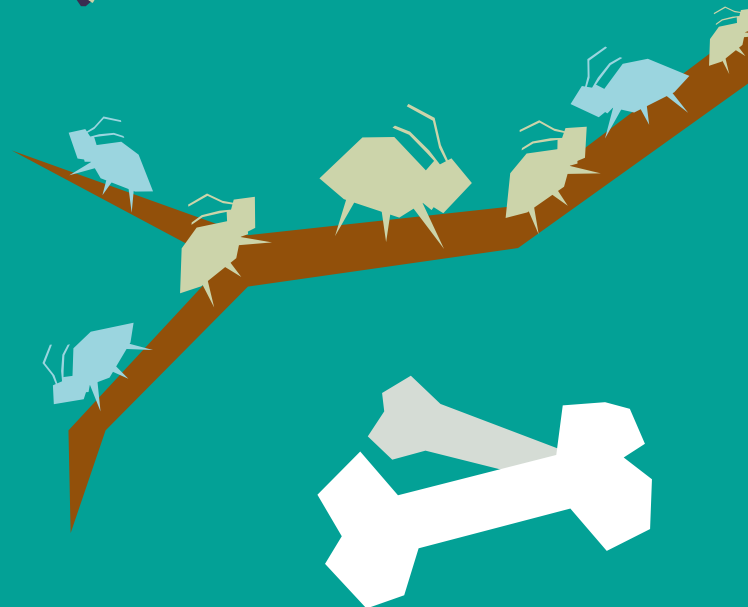

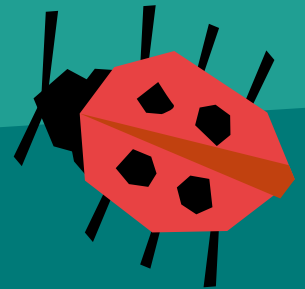
Challenge Awards

- Global Issues – Learn about Endangered animals.
- Space – 1. Find out what Earth looks like from space. 2. Discover what makes our planet special and how it helps life survive. 3. Find out what it's like living on the International Space Station.
- Creative – Make something with moving parts (recycled materials), use Lego/Meccano to build something, or make something with Clay or Plasticine

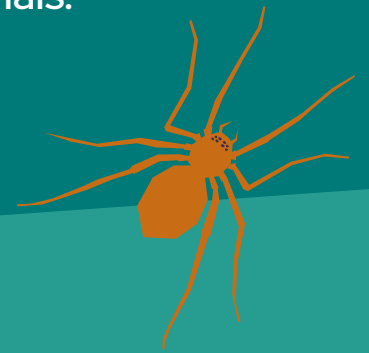
Theme Award: Have Adventures
