### Lyra

"LYE-ruh" The lyre

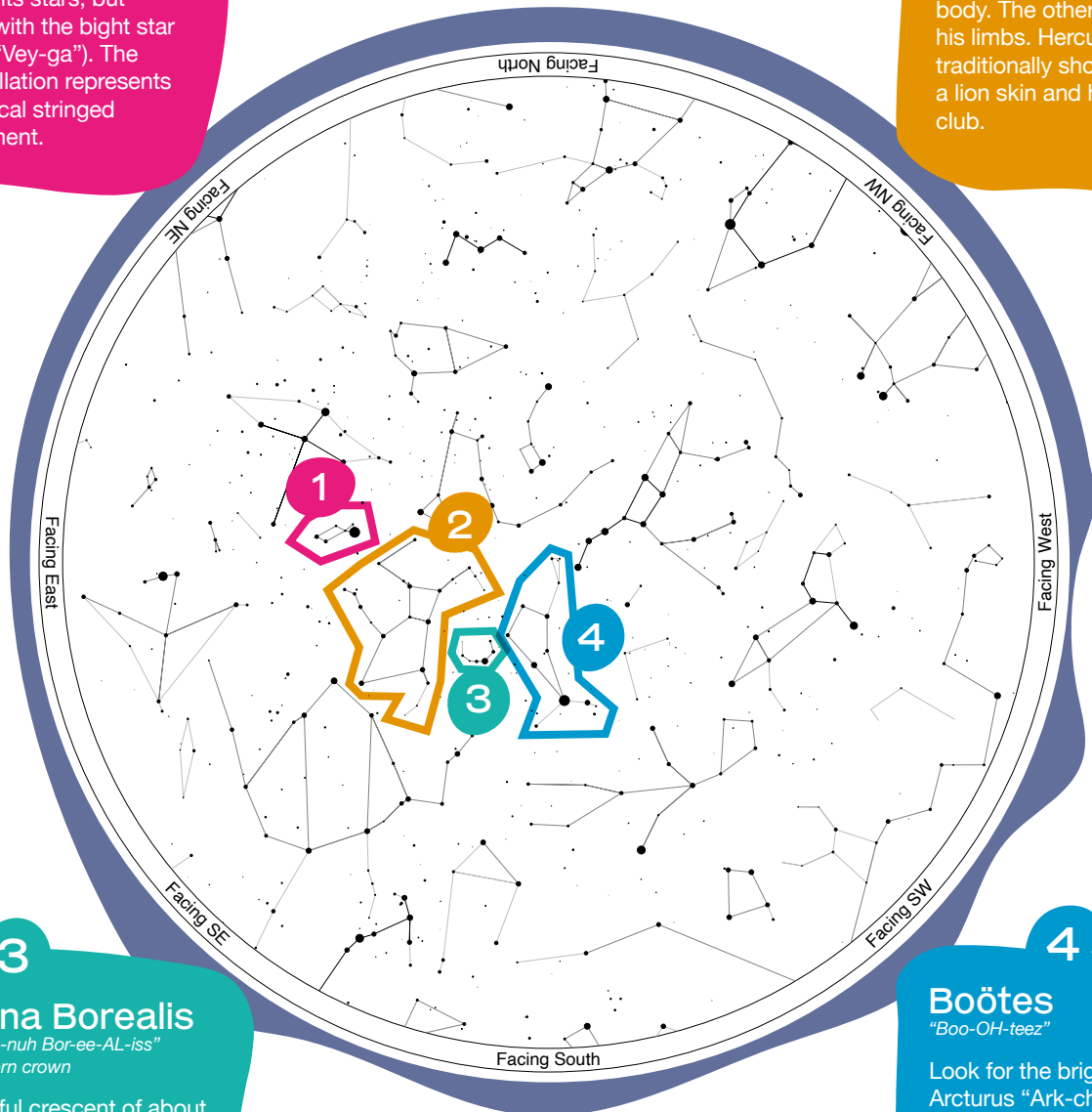
You'll need dark skies to see all its stars, but begin with the bright star Vega ("Vey-ga"). The constellation represents a musical stringed instrument.

### Hercules

"HUR-kyuh-leez" The hero

Look for the central four stars that form the 'keystone' shape of his body. The other stars form his limbs. Hercules is traditionally shown wearing a lion skin and holding a club.

### Corona Borealis

"Cuh-ROA-nuh Bor-ee-AL-iss"  
The northern crown

A beautiful crescent of about seven stars.

### Boötes

"Boo-OH-teez"

Look for the bright star Arcturus "Ark-chur-rus" by following the curve of the plough's handle
