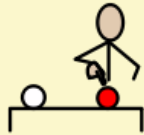

This is a photo of the outside of the building.

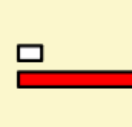
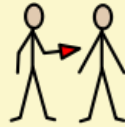


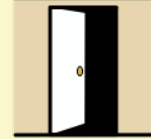
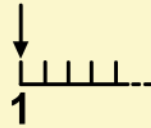
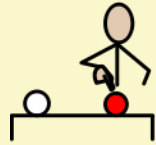


The white dome is the planetarium.





