*"PICE-eez" the fish*

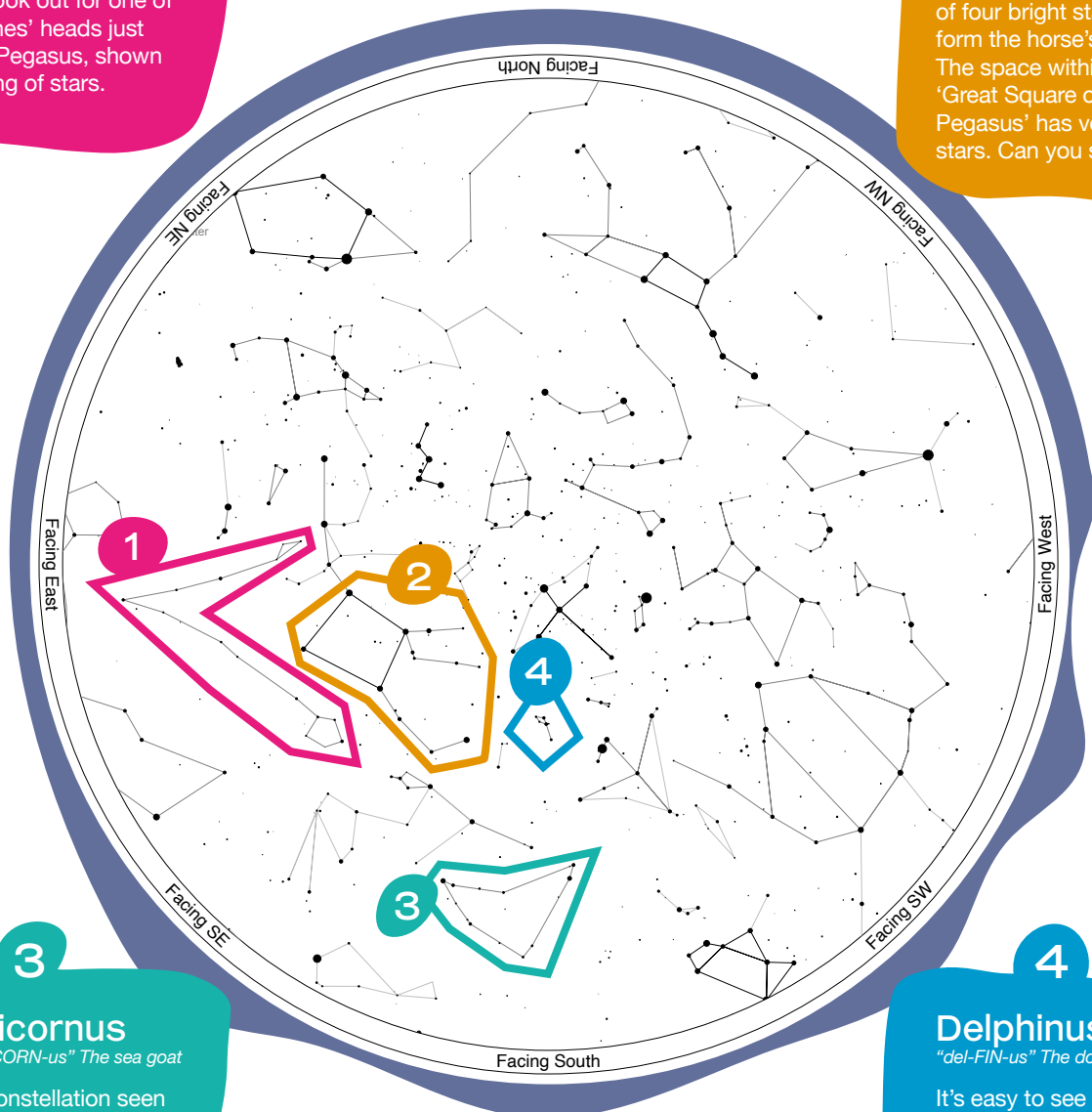
Here is a challenge for you! Look out for one of the fishes' heads just under Pegasus, shown by a ring of stars.

### Pegasus

*"PEG-us-us" The winged horse*

This is a large constellation, easily found by the big square of four bright stars that form the horse's body. The space within the 'Great Square of Pegasus' has very few stars. Can you spot any?

### Capricornus

*"CAP-rih-CORN-us" The sea goat*

A faint constellation seen in the lower third of the sky as a wide arrow head pointing towards the horizon, it's brightest stars making the highest points.

*"del-FIN-us" The dolphin*

It's easy to see how this tiny constellation got its name! You'll need quite a dark night but it's very pretty to see.
